**DEADLINE FOR RECEIPT OF APPLICATION: 31 OCTOBER 2009**

### **ISE TRAVEL GRANTS**

The Executive Committee of the ISE will continue the tradition started in 1988 at the 8<sup>th</sup> Kyoto Congress and provide travel grants.

### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

Preference will be given to young endocrinologists and/or endocrinologists from developing countries who have demonstrated effectiveness in endocrine research. We will work with our member National Societies to identify future potential leaders in Endocrinology.

Endocrinologists must be 35 years of age or under, with first authorship of a submitted abstract to ICE 2010.

Submission of an abstract is a pre-requisite for all travel grant applications. Abstract scores will be an important criterion in the award process.

### **DEADLINE**

Deadline for receipt of completed applications: **31 October 2009**

### **AMOUNT AWARDED**

A total of 75 personal grants of US\$1,500 for trainees outside Asia, US\$1,000 for those within Asia each, will be available for travel and meetings support.

Those receiving travel grants will **not** be exempt from paying the registration fee, but will be invited to an ISE Fellows event at ICE 2010. Reimbursement will be at the Japan meeting in US dollars.

Notice of the travel grant awards will be made by the Office of the Secretary Treasurer on **22 December 2009**.
